

St. Joseph's tests positive for Legionella bacteria

St. Joseph's tests positive for Legionella bacteria

SYRACUSE, N.Y. -- A third test of the water at St. Joseph's Hospital showed Legionella bacteria is still present in the water supply.

The hospital says the bacteria was found in two patient sinks and one ice machine at the hospital.

The hospital first tested positive for the bacteria October 23. The results were preliminary at that time.

The tests were ordered by the New York State Department of Health after three patients at the hospital were diagnosed with Legionnaire's disease.

The hospital stated it believed two of the patients were infected while at the hospital.

The first case was September 24. The second was September 28 and the third case was October 12.
