

Ohio hospital has 10 Legionnaire's disease cases

DAYTON, Ohio — An Ohio hospital has raised the number of patients who have come down with Legionnaire's disease to 10.

The Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton confirmed the latest case on Thursday. Legionnaire's is a potentially deadly form of pneumonia caused by bacteria in water.

The hospital has said that a man in his 70s with Legionnaire's died last month, but not from the disease.

The Dayton Daily News reports testing is trying to determine whether the water system in the hospital's new 12-story addition could be the source of the outbreak.
